The Institute of Fluid Mechanics is looking for tutors for the summer semester of 2026. The tutorials will cover the topics taught in the Fluid Mechanics lecture. Candidates must have achieved at least a good grade (2.3 or higher) in the exam.

The workload is divided as follows:

- Preparation for a total of 9–10 different tutorial topics; for each tutorial there will be a preparatory meeting in which one of you will present the solutions.
- 9–10 on-site tutorial sessions; you may also teach two tutorials per week, in which case the number of hours will be increased accordingly.
- Consultation hour for exam preparation and supervision during the written exam.

The working hours for the tutoring position are **18h/month for one group or 22h/month for two groups** per week. During weeks with a public holiday on Thursday and a bridging day on Friday, as well as during the lecture-free week (25.-30.05.26), no tutorials will take place.
